Understanding Your Schedule

September 9, 2009

Dear Students,

Review this letter carefully **before** requesting a program change. You may realize that no modification to your schedule is necessary.

- **Do not** request a program change because you see the code Z1, Z2, Z3, or Z4. Ignore them. They are for programming purposes only and will be dropped during the second week of school.
- **Do not** request a program change because you have a gym class that does not meet every day of the week. On the days when gym does not meet, students are required to spend the entire period in the library for Study Hall **unless** the period is the first or last of a student's day. In such cases, students will come to school later or go home earlier.
- **Do not** request a program change because you are a twelfth grade art or music student who is scheduled for health class *and* gym. The state requires the school to program students for eight semesters of physical education and one semester of health. The code PPOPH means that you have gym this semester and will have both gym and health next semester.
- **Do not** request a program change because you see the code PPOCL. This means that you will earn gym credit for your participation in the musical. Preparation for *A Chorus Line* will take place after period 9.

If you have submitted the Program Change Request Form, please wait until Wednesday, September 16, for an updated schedule. If you do not receive the classes you desire after that initial change, please review the table below to see when you should meet with your guidance counselor.

Each Team Sports student must report to Mr. Srebnick in Room 313 after his or her final class. Any student who fails to report will fail Team Sports.
